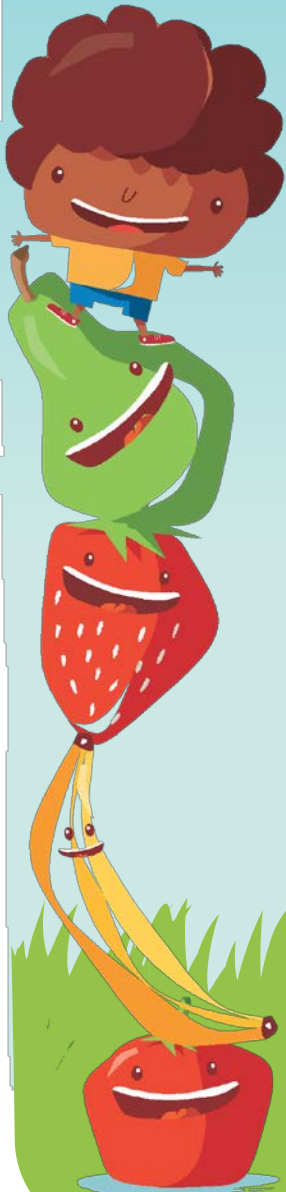


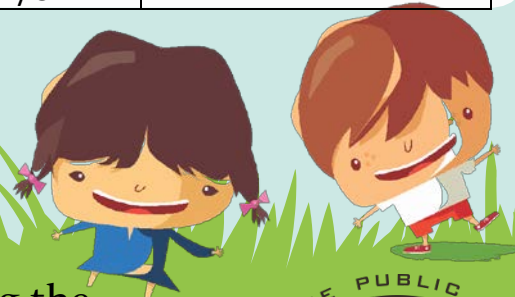
# FREE MEALS FOR KIDS!
