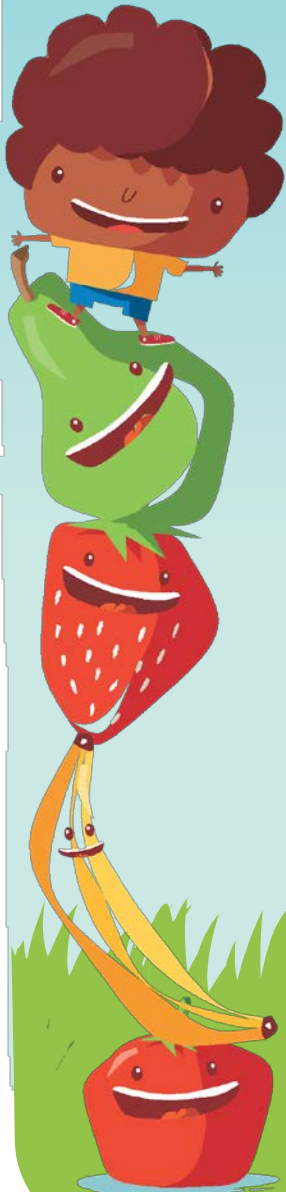


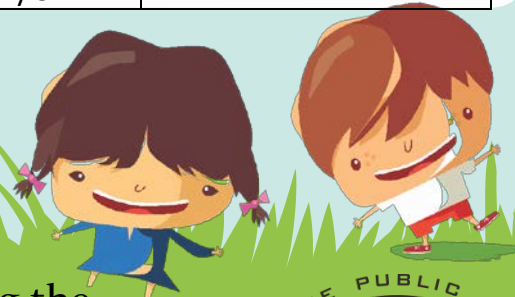
FREE MEALS FOR KIDS!
